

The following are guidelines which should be adhered to ensure a consistent and professional image:

Female Students

- Smart tailored trousers, skirts, tailored dresses (of a suitable length on or over the knee, no leggings, jeans, shorts or sweatpants) in black, navy or dark grey
- Blouses/shirts/tops (long sleeved or short sleeved with shoulders covered)
- Blazer (optional)
- Formal shoes to include smart sandals, or smart trainers in black or white without logos (No flipflops or croc style footwear)
- Tights with denier 50+ plain and no patterned tights,

Male Students

- Smart trousers (no jeans or shorts)
- Button up long or short sleeved collared shirt, tucked in, with/without tie. No patterned shirts. No bright colours
- Blazer (optional)
- Formal shoes, loafers, or smart trainers in black or white without logos (No flipflops or croc style footwear)

Dress Down Thursday

It is acceptable for **Grade 12** students to wear:

- Smart/casual attire including jeans and chinos which should not be ripped or stained in any way.
- SISD Grade 12 class hoodie
- Smart trainers in black or white without logos

It is acceptable for **Grade 11** students to wear:

- Smart/casual attire including jeans and chinos which should not be ripped or stained in any way.
- SISD polo shirt/Neutral colour polo shirt
- Smart trainers in black or white without logos

- Student ID lanyards must be worn at all times for security purposes.
- Hair should be kept neat and well-groomed. Hairstyles and hair colors should be conventional
- Beards should be neatly trimmed. Facial hair should not be unkempt.
- Jewelry should be kept to a minimum
- Clothing and accessories should not be likely to be viewed as offensive, revealing or provocative.
- Clothing and accessories should be absent of any contentious slogans and should not be discriminatory or culturally insensitive

The following is not acceptable;

This is not deemed to be an exhaustive list. If a student has any queries regarding appropriate dress, they should make enquiries with the Deputy Head of Secondary (Pastoral).

- Sports clothing or casual trainers (tracksuits, shorts, trainers or football/rugby shirts)
- Casual shoes such as open toed sandals, trainers that are not black or white, beach shoes or flip flops
- Short skirts (above the knee) or dresses
- Shorts
- Leggings
- T Shirts, sweatshirts, collarless shirts (for male students)
- Low cut tops, vest or tank tops, sheer tops or camisoles showing shoulders/tops of arms (for female students)
- Tattered or faded clothing including ripped or stained clothing

SISD accepts that members of certain ethnic or religious groups are subject to strict religious or cultural requirements in terms of their clothing and appearance and SISD will not insist on dress rules which counter the cultural norm of such students.

If deemed necessary SISD may require a student to go home and change their clothing.

Sanctions for not adhering to the Dress Code Policy

Where a student has been requested on 2 separate occasions to adhere to the dress code policy, on the 3rd occasion where there is a failure to adhere to this policy, it will be recorded as per the school behaviour policy.
