He/she will take responsibility for overseeing the provision of high-quality digital learning and teaching protocol, assuming responsibility for the academic enrichment of students across the school. He/she will always conduct himself/herself in an appropriate professional manner to support and foster the aims and ethos of SISD.
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Main Duties and Responsibilities

Leadership

- Inspire and lead the development, communication, and implementation of a shared vision for the comprehensive use of technology to support education that includes information literacy, programming, design thinking, and innovative learning environments.

- Oversee continued development of all digital teaching and learning (including writing and implementation of curriculum initiatives) through training, mentoring, classroom observation, professional development, departmental meetings, targeted sessions.
- Work alongside the IT Department to ensure that the software and hardware infrastructure of the school can support the digital vision of the school and to secure the safety of students and digital tools used
- Proactively research methods of enhancing teaching and learning to ensure that the school stays abreast of developments in 21st Century learning across the technology sector
- Oversee online and blended learning, future-proofing the school in a context where transformational use of technology can accelerate student progress
- Lead in representing the school externally, taking part in conferences and keeping up to date with digital trends, research, and transformational use of technology.
