Dress Code Policy Grade 11 & 12













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General

- Clothing and accessories should not be offensive or revealing.
- The dress code for G11 and 12 students is Business dress.
- The homeroom teacher and/or the Grade Learning Co-Ordinator will communicate with parents when uniform expectations are not met.

Lanyards

- As G11 & 12 students have opted for a business dress uniform rather than the standard SISD uniform, lanyards must be always worn in line with the SISD health and safety and safeguarding policy.
- If a student arrives at school without a lanyard, they must sign for and borrow a lanyard from security or pastoral team. They must place their phone in exchange for the lanyard and receive their phone on return of the lanyard at the end of the day.
- The school will provide each student with a lanyard. If lost, the student will be liable for the replacement cost.

Male Students







- Smart trousers (suit trousers/ chinos) in black, navy, beige, dark grey.
- Button up long or short sleeved collared shirt, tucked in, optional tie.
- Smart polo t-shirt, with collar and buttoned up.
- Sweater, Blazer (optional)
- Shoes, loafers, or smart trainers. Trainers must be one consistent color, either all white or black.

Female Students



- Smart tailored trousers, skirts, tailored dresses of a suitable length on the knee.
- Blouses/shirts/tops must be long sleeved or short sleeved with shoulders covered. All blouses/shirts/tops must be of adequate length to cover the midriff.
- Smart polo tee shirt, with collar and buttoned up.
- Blazer (optional).
- Formal shoes or smart trainers. Trainers must be one consistent color, either all white or all black. No open style footwear.

The following would not be deemed acceptable:

- Sports clothing, clothing with hood or sports trainers.
- Casual shoes such as open toed sandals, trainers that are bright colors, beach shoes or flip-flops.
- Short skirts or dresses (above the knee).
- No bright or loud colors.
- Leggings.

- Shorts.
- T Shirts, sweatshirts, collarless shirts for male students.
- Low cut tops, vest or tank tops, sheer tops or camisoles showing shoulders/tops of arms.

Consequences for non-compliance

- 1st reminder conversation with the student, logged on Isams with a follow up phone call to parents with an agreed timeline compliance.
- 2nd reminder conversation with the student, logged on Isams with a follow up formal written communication to parents.
- 3rd incident Referral to Grade Learning Coordinator.
- 4th incident Referral to Grade Learning Coordinator and Deputy Head.
