



Rules for riding the School Bus
Buses depart on time. Once the first bus starts to depart, students will not be able to board in any bus.



1. Students must adhere to the instruction of the bus attendant.
2. Students are to use the established pick up/drop-off point.
3. Students are permitted to get off the bus only at their assigned stops unless they have a note from their parents. These notes need to be pre-approved by the transportation coordinator.
4. Students are required to stay in their assigned seats.
5. Students must keep their seat belt fasten throughout the journey.
6. Students are to refrain from sticking out their head, hands and other objects out of the window.
7. Speak in a quiet voice.
8. Students are not allowed to eat and drink on the bus. Water is only permitted.
9. Any potential dangerous objects that need to be transported, (e.g. glass, knives etc.) are to be handed over to bus attendant.
10. Bus will not wait at the designed stops in the morning for late students.
11. Buses will not move unless all students are seated.
12. Students will be suspended from the bus for any aggressive, abusive or otherwise unacceptable behavior.
13. Students, who attempt to stop the bus while it is in motion, will be suspended from the bus and will be considered for permanent removal from the use of the bus service.
14. If a bus delayed from leaving the school because of a student being late, the student will ride home and the bus supervisor will refer him/her to the principal (the next day).
15. Student conduct that places other bus riders at risk will be considered as grounds for permanent removal from the use of the bus service.
