### THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

SISD is a PreK to Grade 12 co-educational IB continuum day and boarding school. Established in 2015 as a bilingual IB school, the school is one of a kind in the UAE. With a focus on bilingualism, and a desire to bring Swiss Excellence to the UAE, the school also has the added uniqueness of being one of only a handful of boarding schools in the GCC region. The school currently accommodates 1500 students, from 75 nationalities, and has a teaching body of 300 staff, from over 25 nationalities. This multicultural community, and multilingual environment enhances and enriches our students' education. Students have access to a world-class campus, superb teaching and learning spaces, exceptional sports facilities and dynamic performing arts rooms and technology.

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### THE CURRICULUM

As a private, co-educational day and boarding school, we offer four International Baccalaureate (IB) programmes: the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), Diploma Programme (DP) and Career-Related Programme (CP). Following the UAE's educational guidelines, all students must take Arabic until the end of Grade 9, while students who are citizens of Arabic speaking countries are required to study Arabic until graduation. Muslim students study Islamic Education as part of their academic schedule through the end of Grade 12. Students in Grades 9-12 follow a university preparatory programme culminating in the IB's Full Diploma, Diploma Courses (Certificate) Programme or Career-Related Programme.

### THE MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP):

A rigorous and innovative five-year programme for students aged 11-16 (Grades 6-10 at SISD). Students take one subject from each of the following eight areas each year:

- 1. Arts; 2. Design; 3. Health & Physical Education;
- 4. Individuals and Societies; 5. Languages and Literature;
- 6. Language Acquisition; 7. Mathematics; 8. Science.

The MYP helps every child see their studies through a global lens. Students learn how to conceptualize their learning and think critically about the value of the content, how the content is presented and why they are engaged in every learning activity. In the final year of the MYP, Grade 10 students at SISD complete the Personal Project. This activity represents the end of our students' journey thought the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme. Through this culminating project, students demonstrate the knowledge they have gained and what skills they have acquired in a powerful and personal statement through a variety of mediums. Also, throughout their journey in the MYP, SISD students have the opportunities to take part in a robust and meaningful Service and Action programme. This adds to the value of an already creative and rigorous curriculum to help them realize their potential both in and out of the classroom. There is no better way for students to prepare for the most challenging pre-university programme in the world, the IB Diploma Programme (DP), than the MYP. The academic demands, training in critical thinking and skill development in addition to hands-on programmes in the Arts and Design, mean students will leave the MYP well-rounded and ready to take on the challenges of the DP. More importantly they will have had the opportunity to discover talents they did not yet know they possessed.

### THE IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (DP)

The DP is a demanding university preparatory programme that leads to external exams. The DP curriculum emphasizes critical thinking, intercultural understanding, research skills and community service. Approximately 90% of SISD students in Grades 11 and 12 are enrolled in the full DP, with the remainder enrolled in Diploma Courses or the Career-Related Programme. The IB Diploma will be awarded to a candidate provided all the following requirements have been met: all CAS requirements, the candidate's total points are 24 or more, there is no grade E awarded for Theory of Knowledge and/or the Extended Essay, there is no grade 1 awarded in a subject/level, there are no more than two grade 2's awarded (HL or SL), the candidate has gained 12 points or more in HL subjects, and the candidate has gained 9 points or more on SL subjects.

### THE IB CAREER-RELATED PROGRAMME (CP)

The CP is an alternative pathway to the DP, providing students with a greater level of experiential learning. CP students must score a 3 or higher in a minimum of two DP courses, one of which must be English. CP students must fulfill all of their BTEC requirements, complete Service Learning requirements, a Personal and Professional Skills portfolio, a Language Development portfolio and score a D or higher on their Reflective Project.

### **EVALUATION SCHEME**

SISD conforms to the IB system with grades ranging from 7 (high) to 1 (low), with the exception of BTEC, TOK and EE/RP which is reported A (high) to E (low). The system is used for all internal and external assessments and on official transcripts. SISD only provides end of year grades on High School transcripts. Should a mid-year transcript be required for Grade 12 students, it should be noted that the grades are only preliminary and an updated transcript with final grades will be provided at the end of Grade 12. The Diploma Programme at SISD has minimum entrance requirements for Grade 10 students, details of which are available on the school website. Students who do not qualify for the Full DP can enroll in the Diploma Courses or Career-Related Programmes.










